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2026 Sec 3 Subject Options Online Briefing for Parents and Students - 4 April Friday

During the session, we will inform parents and students about the Sec 3 subject options and combinations for 2026, the indicative criteria for specific subjects and post-secondary education pathways.
- Your child/ward is the inaugural batch of students under FSBB, sitting for the SEC in 2027. The "SEC" in Singapore refers to the Singapore-Cambridge Secondary Education Certificate exam, which will replace the current O-Level and N-Level examinations starting from 2027, essentially becoming the single national secondary school leaving exam for all students in Singapore; it signifies a move towards a unified system without streaming in secondary education.
- 14 Attendance is **compulsory** for all students. Details about the briefing will be given closer to the event through Parents Gateway.

Our Secondary 2 (PG1) students have been given the opportunity to participate in the Experience ITE Programme (EIP) on Monday, 26 May 2025, from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm at ITE College Central. The EIP is specially designed to provide students with an authentic learning experience through ITE's Hands-On, Minds-On, Hearts-On education. Students will take part in fun and practical projects to develop an interest in skills-based learning and gain insights into skills-related professions.

Practical coding sessions will empower students to train their own Al models and design functional chatbots, all while critically analysing the ethical implications of Al in our modern world.

Performing Arts-Based Learning (PABL) - 28 May Wednesday 2.30 - 5.30 pm

Our Sec 2 students will be attending PABL (Performing Arts-Based Learning), which aims to shape the students' collective identity and memory through music, jointly developed and funded by the Ministry of Education (MOE) and National Arts Council (NAC). PABL is a core learning experience in the lower secondary Music curriculum, providing every student with the opportunity to experience a bespoke live music performance. The programme also aims to nurture pride in local music and musicians, while fostering familiarity with our vibrant arts scene. The tickets are fully subsidised by MOE.
