- Make a decision and take action based on your options.

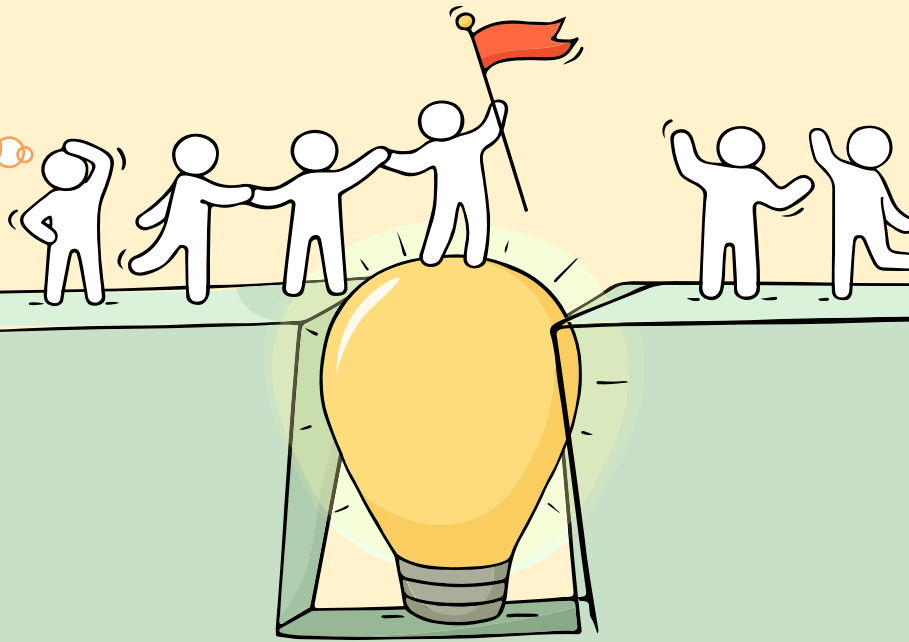
When you receive your results, you may experience a range of emotions.

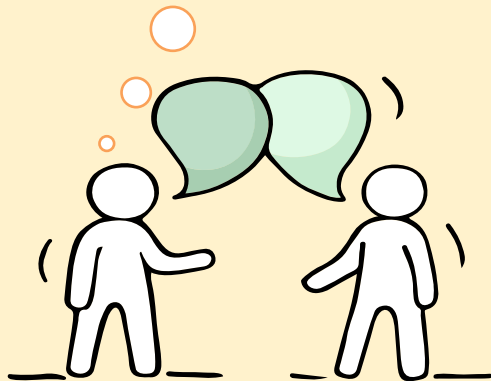

Progression to Sec 5NA

i. *Promotion Criteria from Sec 4N(A) to Sec 5N(A)*

2 Sec 4N(A) students can be promoted to Sec 5N(A) if they satisfy **all** the following criteria:

- (a) Sat for the GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2023;
- (b) Obtained an ELMAB3 aggregate score of 19 points or less; and
- (c) Obtained at least an N(A)-Level Grade 5¹ for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3; and
- (d) Will not be more than:
 - i) 4 years overage, for Singapore Citizens (SC)/ Permanent Residents (PR) (i.e. should be born on or after 2 Jan 2003), or
 - ii) 2 years overage, for International Students (IS) (i.e. should be born on or after 2 Jan 2005).

Progression to **DPP** [JIE ‘H’]

- 6 In lieu of progressing to Sec 5N(A), Sec 4N(A) students may consider enrolling into two-year *Higher Nitec* courses at ITE through the DPP. DPP students who successfully complete their *Higher Nitec* courses and attain the minimum qualifying Grade Point Average (GPA) are subsequently guaranteed a place in a polytechnic diploma course mapped to their *Higher Nitec* course.
- 7 Sec 4N(A) students may apply for the DPP if they satisfy **all** the following criteria:
- (a) Sat for their GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2023 as school candidates;
 - (b) Obtained a raw ELMAB3 aggregate score of **19 points or less³** (excluding CCA bonus points); and
 - (c) Met subject-specific entry requirements for each course, as stated in <https://www.ite.edu.sg/admissions/full-time-courses/higher-nitec-dpp>.
- 8 Following the release of the GCE N(A)-Level results in December 2023, DPP-eligible students may submit an application online via the ITE website (<https://www.ite.edu.sg>). Successful applicants will be required to attend a 10-week preparatory course prior to commencing their *Higher Nitec* courses. More information can be found at <https://www.ite.edu.sg/admissions/full-time-courses/higher-nitec-dpp>.

Progression to PFP

- 10 Sec 4N(A) students may apply for the PFP if they satisfy **all** the following criteria:
- (a) Sat for their GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2023 as school candidates;
 - (b) Obtained a **raw ELMAB3 aggregate score of 12 points or less⁴** (excluding CCA bonus points); and
 - (c) Met the subject-specific entry requirements stated in https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/pfp_eligibility.html.
- 13 Sec 4N(A) students have the following options in applying for the PFP and DPP:
- (a) Students who are only interested in applying for the PFP should first progress to Sec 5N(A), even if they meet the PFP eligibility criteria based on their GCE N(A)-Level results in December 2023. They may then apply for the PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2024. If their application is successful, they will withdraw from Sec 5N(A) by the end of January 2024⁵. **All PFP-bound students are required to attend Sec 5N(A) classes in their secondary schools up till the last Friday of January 2024, i.e. 26 January 2024.**

Retention of Sec 4 (NA) students

14 Sec 4N(A) students are eligible to repeat their GCE N(A)-Level Examination as school candidates if they satisfy all the following criteria:

(a) Obtained an aggregate score:

- i) Not exceeding 21 points for ELMAB3 (i.e. **ELMAB3** \leq 21), or
- ii) Not exceeding 14 points for ELB3 (English Language and best three other subjects, which can include Mathematics) (i.e. **ELB3** \leq 14), or
- iii) Not exceeding 14 points for MAB3 (Mathematics and best three other subjects, which can include English Language) (i.e. **MAB3** \leq 14); and

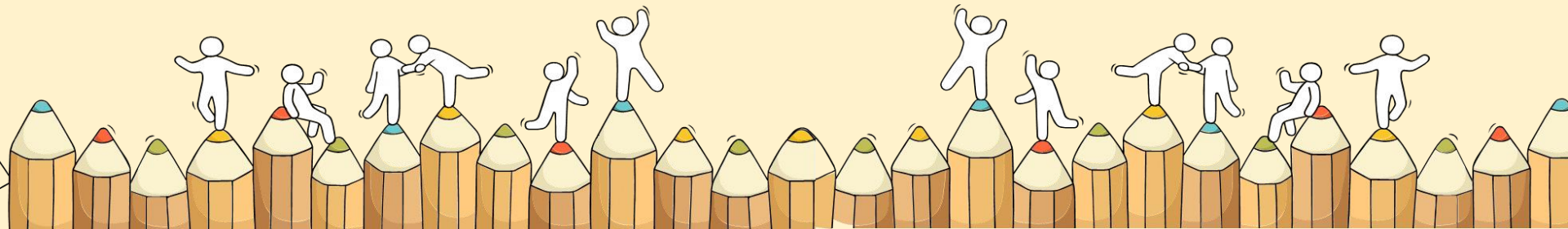
(b) Will not be more than:

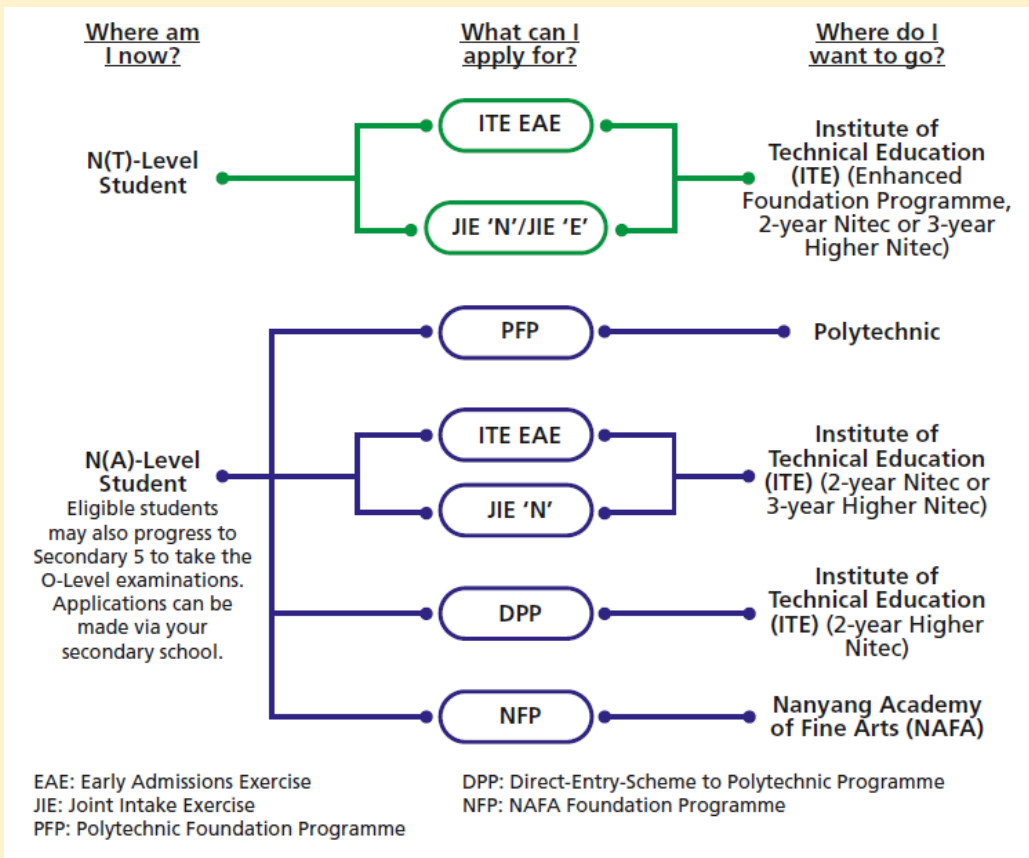
- i) 4 years overage, for SC/PR (i.e. should be born on or after 2 Jan 2004), or
- ii) 2 years overage, for IS (i.e. should be born on or after 2 Jan 2006)⁷; and

(c) Sat for the GCE N(A)-Level Examination for the first time in 2023.

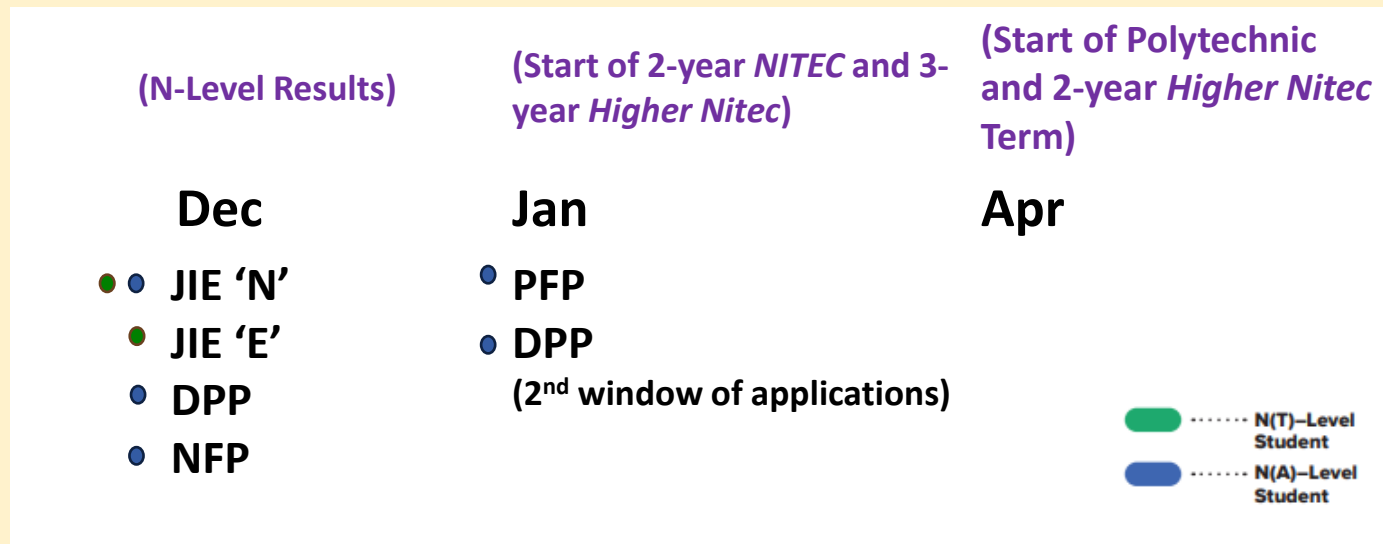

PFP is a one-year programme that offers a practice-oriented curriculum taught by polytechnic lecturers to better prepare polytechnic-bound Secondary 4 N(A) students for entry into selected polytechnic diploma courses. PFP students are given provisional places in diploma programmes, subject to them passing all modules in the one-year programme.

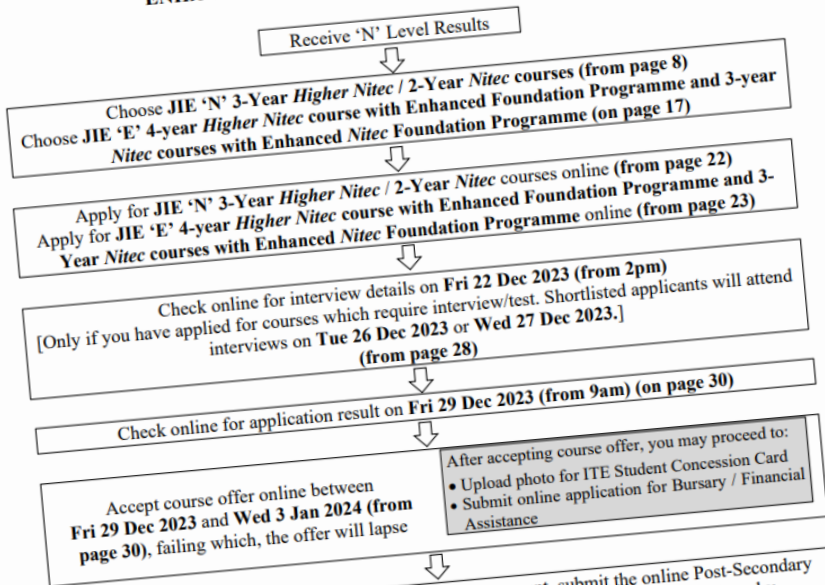

1. All N(A)* /N(T) school leavers are encouraged to put in an application during the **1st Phase (Main Phase)** between **18 Dec 2023 (2.30pm) to 21 Dec 2023 (5pm)**. Application results for the 1st Phase will be released on **29 Dec 2023 at 9am**.
2. If you wish to appeal, please accept the course offered **before** applying in the **2nd Phase (Late Application/Appeal Phase)** between **29 Dec 2023 to 3 Jan 2024**. The application results for the 2nd Phase will be known on **10 Jan 2024 at 9am**.
3. Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the **3rd Phase (Final Top-up Phase)** between **10 Jan to 18 Jan 2024 and 24 Jan to 7 Feb 2024** for courses with vacancies. The application results for the 3rd Phase will be known between **15 Jan to 24 Jan 2024** and **24 Jan to 14 Feb 2024**.

Key Pointers for Students on ITE's Joint Intake Exercise (JIE) for Admission to Nitec Courses

ALL N(T) students and N(A) students (who are not progressing to 5N(A) or repeating 4N(A)) are eligible for JIE.

Keen competition for Nitec and Higher Nitec courses, so use all 12 choices wisely!

Participation in Main Phase is key to secure a place in ITE!

If you are keen in the work & learn option, you may consider applying for the ITE Traineeship programme. Do apply in the Main Phase to avoid missing a place in ITE!

If you are unsuccessful in EAE, make sure you apply in Main Phase to avoid missing a place!

If you have received an additional letter, then you are ~~eligible for the~~ Enhanced Foundation Programme.

If you are eligible for EFP, make sure you apply for the 2-year Nitec and 3-year Higher Nitec first before applying for EFP!

The EFP helps to build the necessary literacy and numeracy foundations that will enable you to successfully complete your Nitec course!




If you are counter-offered a course, accept it first before appealing for another course you may be more interested in!

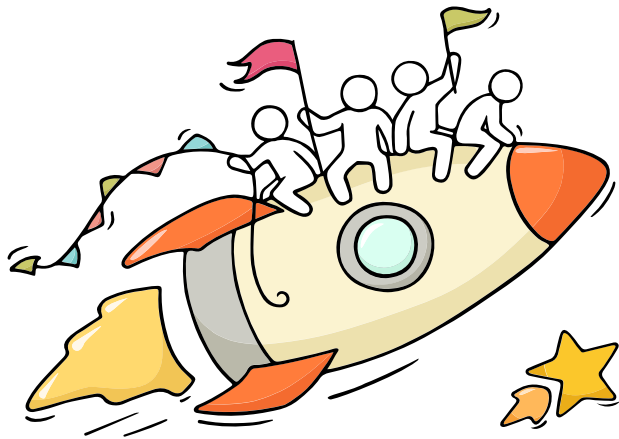
